#### Applications

Publishing, corporate communication, letterhead, covers and sleeves, greeting and invitation cards.

#### Utilisation

Inkjet and laser printer : printing quality guaranteed up to 135 gsm.  
Other elements : offset, letterpress, silk screen, thermography, foil blocking, die stamping, embossing, varnishing...

#### Printing recommendation

Screen ruling Antinoë brut : 150 lpi.

It is recommended to use positive-drying inks or fully oxidising inks. It is recommended to use positive drying inks or fully oxidising inks. For the paper the grain size of the anti-set-off-spray powder should be 20 microns, for the board 35 microns. In case of following laser printing the use of specific ink is advisable.

#### Varnishing

Pre-creasing or scoring is required for 160 gsm and up.  
Folds should follow the machine or grain direction.

#### Folding

Pre-creasing or scoring is required for 160 gsm and up.

#### Packaging and storage

Store the wrapped paper in the printing machine room until it has adapted to the room temperature.

Only remove the wrapping paper shortly before printing.
